This commemorative ceremony will be held on Wednesday, August 20, 2014, at the 4H Fair South County Park at 4:00 p.m.

The Hunterdon County Veterans Recognition Medal was first commissioned by the Board of Chosen Freeholders in 2002. The design for which was created by John N. Hatzikalfas, a Hunterdon County resident and Vietnam War Veteran.

The Board of Chosen Freeholders, on behalf of the citizens of Hunterdon County dutifully and gratefully acknowledges your personal sacrifice in the protection of our freedom, rights and the American people. And, as is appropriately emblazoned on the medal: "We Shall Never Forget"
