| <p style="text-align: center;">EXPLANATORY STATEMENT</p> <p>As set forth in the Proposal, the Board is seeking authorization to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Redesign/upgrade the media center to be a collaborative learning commons and maker space;• Upgrade lighting, replace ceilings;• Replace a boiler nearing its lifespan;• Upgrade interior and exterior doors for safety and security; and• HVAC upgrades to improve air flow and air quality <p>The total project costs shall not exceed \$985,000. The Board has received an award of State funding (debt service aid) in the amount of 40% of the total project costs which State funding reduces the taxpayers' share of the project to 60%.</p> <p><u>The 40% State contribution will only be available if this Proposal is approved by the voters.</u></p> | |
| <p style="text-align: center;">PROPOSAL</p> <p>The Board of Education of the Clinton-Glen Gardner School District in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey is authorized to undertake a school facilities project consisting of the renovation/upgrade of the Media Center, lighting/ceiling replacement, boiler replacement, interior and exterior door upgrades and HVAC upgrades. The Board is authorized to expend on such project and issue bonds for such project in an amount not to exceed \$985,000. The State has agreed to provide debt service aid in the amount of 40% of the "final eligible costs" of the school facilities project.
