



## ***VETERANS' ID CARDS AVAILABLE AT COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE***

Veterans can register their DD-214 Discharge papers with the County Clerk's office. Registering this form affords the veteran the security of knowing that his/her records are permanently recorded.

When recording your DD-214, we now offer a County Veteran Identification Card that provides Veteran's name, address, and file number of their recorded DD-214. This service is **FREE OF CHARGE** to all honorably discharged Hunterdon County Veterans. This card can be an easy reference that may be used at a future date to obtain a certified copy of your discharge papers if a situation arises where they can not be located quickly.

**Any discharge documents on file with the County Clerk are considered confidential and can only be accessed by veterans or their family.**
