The Progressive Center for Independent Living, with offices in Flemington and Hamilton, a leading advocacy agency for people with disabilities, is seeking young adults ages 17-25 to participate in a 15 week pre-employment program, Career Gateway, starting on Nov. 4.

**Career Gateway**, is an innovative program that teaches young adults with disabilities the necessary skills to enter the workforce and maintain employment. Ultimately, the goal is to teach students how to succeed in a work environment and live independently.

Students who participate in the program attend classes for fifteen weeks every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon, learning skills like balancing a checkbook, paying bills, budgeting, searching for a job, appropriate workplace behaviors and the proper interview techniques.

Students will also participate in (3) six-hour "job samplings" where they job-shadow a mentor at a business that meets their career aspirations.

Career Gateway is funded through a grant from the state Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services. There is no cost for students to participate, only that they contact their DVR counselor for eligibility.
