Recycling and Bulky Trash Drop Off Available To Hunterdon County Residents

The Hunterdon County Transfer Station is a recycling and solid waste disposal facility located at 10 Petticoat Lane, in Annandale. The Transfer Station is open to all Hunterdon County residents to drop off recycling and bulky household items at specific times.

The County's hazardous waste drop off and electronics disposal days will be scheduled in the near future.

Bulky Household Drop Off:

ON SATURDAYS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:30 AM AND 12:45 PM

Open to private individuals to **dispose of bulky household trash for a fee**. A private individual can dispose of any basement, attic, garage or yard cleanup. The resident must use a privately licensed vehicle, licensed under 8,000 pounds gross weight. There are three criteria that must be met:

1. The resident must have passenger or farm plates on their vehicle. Vehicles must be licensed under 8,000 pounds. NO COMMERCIAL OR APPORTIONED VEHICLES WILL BE ADMITTED.
2. The resident is responsible for the off-load of his trash. THE TRANSFER STATION DOES NOT SUPPLY HELP WITH THE OFF-LOAD OF YOUR WASTE.
3. The resident must pay cash for the disposal, the transfer station DOES NOT ACCEPT PERSONAL CHECKS OR CREDIT CARDS.

CURRENT RATE: Effective April 01, 2008:

- Automobiles - \$22.00
- Trucks - \$32.00
- Trailers - \$10.00 - Charges for Trailers will be made at the discretion of the transfer station operator.

WASTE THAT IS ACCEPTED:

- Basement, Attic, and Garage Cleanup materials
- Yard Cleanup: Branches and tree clippings, NO LEAVES OR GRASS CLIPPINGS
- Construction Debris: FOUR (4) FOOT SECTIONS OR LESS ONLY.
- Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners NEED a FREON REMOVAL CERTIFICATION before disposal.
- FREE REFRIGERATOR/FREEZER RECYCLING BY THE STATE
 - The New Jersey BPU has a program for recycling refrigerators and/or freezers for free with a \$50 incentive. This offer is valid through June 30, 2017 and is available to residential customers of JCP&L. Click here for more information. www.state.nj.us/dep/dshw/recycling/stats.htm

WASTE NOT ACCEPTED:

- Liquids
- Household trash (put at curb for garbage hauler)
- Tires
- Hazardous Waste (take to a County Hazardous Waste Cleanup Day)
- LEAVES OR GRASS CLIPPINGS
- Asbestos (Contact a hauler licensed to haul this material or take to a County Hazardous Waste Cleanup Day)

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING:

- **Aluminum cans:** Only empty beverage cans will be accepted.
 - Other aluminum items ARE NOT BE ACCEPTED
- **Cardboard, chipboard & brown paper bags:** Corrugated, chipboard (boxboard) and brown paper bags will be accepted. Cardboard should be tied or placed in another cardboard container (box).
 - Cardboard with food or food residue WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- **Glass bottles and jars:** Food and beverage container glass with rings and caps removed will be accepted. All containers MUST be emptied and rinsed.
 - Cups, drinking glasses, dishes, ovenware, window glass, lead crystal TV tubes, light bulbs, mirrors or any other type of glass product WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- **Hard covered books**
- **Junk mail & office paper:** Unshredded junk mail and office paper will be accepted. Junk mail and office paper should be tied or placed in a cardboard container (box).
 - Shredded or Bagged junk mail and office paper WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- **Newspaper:** Newspaper tied with string or twine will be accepted.
 - Newspaper bound in tape or other materials WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- **Paperback books**
- **Plastics bottles # 1-7:** Plastic bottles # 1-7 that originally contained liquids are accepted. All containers MUST be emptied and rinsed.
- **Telephone books**
- **Tin and bi-metal cans:** Are accepted if all food and other residue has been removed. Labels do not have to be removed.
