## Hunterdon County Division of Senior Services Announces Mr. Fix-It Appliance Day, Thursday, April 26, 9a – 12noon

Each year the Division of Senior Services offers a day to the Seniors of Hunterdon County for small appliance repairs. These repairs are free of charge and made possible through the generosity of volunteers.

Freeholder Deputy Director Suzanne Lagay said at a recent Board Meeting, "We currently have five volunteers scheduled to be on hand at the Senior Center on Gauntt Place, April 26, from 9am to 12noon. We greatly appreciate those who volunteer their time to provide this help for our senior community."

Any Hunterdon County senior may bring their small appliances to the center and a volunteer will repair it, if possible. The senior is responsible for the cost of the materials, but the labor is free. No appointment is needed.

Freeholder Deputy Director Lagay said, "While the service does not provide for computer or cell phone repair, it has been a very helpful and successful service for our seniors and is organized by our Senior services team, led by Laine Nauman."

Some of the items eligible for repair on April 26 are:

- Lamps that need rewiring or a new socket, because the 2 or 3 way doesn't work anymore
- Vacuum cleaners
- Toasters
- Toaster ovens
- Radio's
- Electric tea kettles
- Repairing screens or totally rescreening a window frame
