Honoring Veterans, Celebrating Agriculture Hunterdon County 4-H Fair Begins August 22

A large contingent of Hunterdon County Veterans will be honored for their military service, as Hunterdon County's 2018 4-H & Agricultural Fair holds its Opening Ceremonies, on Wednesday August 22, at 4 pm, at the Roger K. Everitt Fairgrounds, South County Park, in Ringoes. The Fair runs through Sunday, August 26.

Hunterdon County Freeholder Board Director Matt Holt said, "The 4H Fair brings together two of the most significant elements of life in our County and our Nation, honoring our Veterans and celebrating the importance of agriculture.

The Freeholders are proud to be a part of the Veterans Recognition Medal program. Let's never forget that military service entails sacrifice and dedication, and we cannot say thank you enough to those who have served our Nation."

Holt continued, "Agriculture gives our County its distinction. It is an integral part of our economic system, our history and our culture. The 4-H Fair serves to highlight agriculture as a way of life and gives residents who are engaged in those pursuits an opportunity to demonstrate their proficiency."
