Hunterdon County, New Jersey
Notice of Public Comment Period and Public Hearing

Background - The County of Hunterdon is the recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV1 and CV3) funds.

Available Funds - The County has been advised by the State of New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, that it will receive a grant allocation of \$460,971 in CDBG-CV1 and CV3 funds.

Range of Eligible Activities - Funds available under the CDBG CV Program may be used for a wide range of activities including public facilities. Per New Jersey Department of Community Affairs the following municipalities are eligible to apply for CDBG CV1 and CV3 funds: Bloomsbury, Flemington, Glen Gardner, and Hampton. The County invited the aforementioned municipalities to apply for CDBG CV funds to support public facility projects that met the CDBG CV guidelines to prepare for, respond to or prevent Coronavirus.

Program Limitations – CDBG-CV has legislative and regulatory limitations on the use of funds which restrict the types of projects and activities which may be funded under these programs, including the requirement that funds must principally benefit persons of low or moderate-income. As a result, the range of eligible activities under these programs is subject to these legislative and regulatory limitations including provisions of the CARES act.

Based on the proposals received, the County anticipates that 70% of the CDBG-CV funds will be used in a manner which will benefit low and moderate income-persons as defined by federal regulations.

Proposed Annual Action Plan – The County does not receive CDBG funds directly from HUD and the CDBG-CV funds are exempt from submitting an annual action plan.
