Free Vision Screening At The Hunterdon County Health Department

The Hunterdon County Health Department is partnering with the NJ Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired (CBVI) to provide FREE eye screening for low income and uninsured individuals.

This service will be offered MONTHLY at the Hunterdon County Health Department, with the first clinic scheduled for Thursday, May 25th. Appointments are required.
