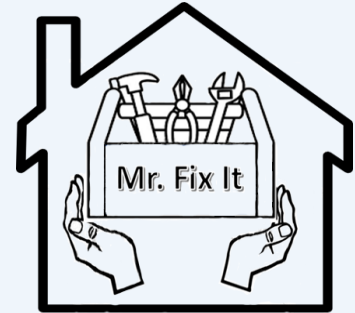


Volunteers Needed!

- You choose the area of the county you would like to cover
- Identify your Skills (chores, plumbing, electrical work, etc.)
- Seniors call the Division of Senior, Disabilities and Veterans Services at 908-788-1358 with requests or they can email mrfixit@co.hunterdon.nj.us
- The Mr. Fix-It Coordinator matches the request to the volunteers' abilities and preferences and phones the volunteer to ask of their availability for the job
- The volunteer either accepts or rejects the assignment
