**BOND PROPOSAL QUESTION**

The Board of Education of the Township of Union in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to provide for HVAC and electrical service upgrades and installation of safety doors at Union Township Middle School, including acquisition and installation of equipment, site work and related work and costs; (b) to appropriate \$2,750,000 for such purposes, and (c) to issue bonds of the school district therefore in the principal amount of \$2,750,000.

The final eligible costs of the projects approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$2,749,399. The proposed improvements include \$0 for elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.
