At the Flemington traffic circle, take Route 31 North for approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto West Woodschurch Road and follow the signs to Deer Path Park.

From the Clinton Area:
From US Interstate 78, take Route 31 South for approximately 6.5 miles. Take right jug handle onto West Woodschurch Road and follow the signs to Deer Path Park.
