### **Drive-In Concerts And Movies Planned At Hunterdon's South County Park**

The County Parks & Recreation Division released dates for concerts and movies in the park this summer, starting on June 17, Hunterdon County Commissioner Matt Holt announced at the April 6 Commissioner Board Meeting.

Commissioner Holt, the Board's Parks liaison, said, "These are great free programs provided by the County. I know that last year, despite the limits on participation because of the COVID-19 restrictions, the events were very well received and well attended."

The concerts will be held on Thursdays, June 17, July 8, July 22, and August 5. All will be drive-in concerts similar to last year at the South County Park. The acts will be announced at a later date.

Dan Bush, Parks & Recreation Division Head, said, "The Concerts and Movies in the Park are a free opportunity for the public to enjoy outdoors. It was particularly important last year with all of the COVID-19 restrictions and Governor of NJ Executive Orders that Parks was able to hold safe events while following all guidance to protect public safety.

This years' offerings will continue to follow that same conservative approach that is family friendly and safety conscious to do our best to support public health and outdoor activities."

Due to the success of the drive-in movies in the park last year, Commissioner Holt also announced the Parks Division will hold drive-in movies at South County Park on September 4 and September 18, with rain dates on September 9 and September 23, if needed. The movies will also be announced at a later date.

"I am advised that the Parks Division will work in tandem with state executive orders and the County Health Department regarding attendance limits at the time of the events. It is my sincere hope that the health climate will improve, and more individuals and families will be able to enjoy these activities," Holt concluded.
