**Hunterdon County Killed In Action Honor Flag Renewal Ceremony**

**At Historic Courthouse**

**October 7<sup>th</sup> at 3pm, Veterans And The Public Are Invited**

Hunterdon County is holding a refreshed Killed In Action (KIA) Honor Flag Ceremony outside of the County's Historic Courthouse in Flemington, tomorrow, October 7<sup>th</sup>, at 3pm.

The KIA Honor Flag Ceremony, hosted by Commissioner Director Susan J. Soloway, will include the county's Veterans Service Officer Rich Booth, Sheriff's Officer Maria Dulmer, remarks from Commissioner Zachary T. Rich, TAPS performed by NJTAPS member Ron Lawrence, and a benediction from Pastor Nathan Tuckey of the South Ridge Community Church in Clinton.

The respectful ceremony has been planned to refresh the KIA Honor Flag after its initial raising in 2018 by Hunterdon County, along with the county's twenty-six municipalities, who are receiving complimentary KIA Honor Flags so that they may raise a refreshed flag as well.

Veterans, and the public, are invited to attend the ceremony.
