### Early Voting Begins In Hunterdon County

**Saturday, October 23 Through Sunday, October 31**

**At Three Locations**

**Voters Can Also Vote In-Person At Their Usual Polling Locations On**

**Election Day, November 2nd**

Early voting, established by a new state law, will begin on Saturday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> in Hunterdon County and runs through October 31<sup>st</sup>, Hunterdon County Board of Commissioners Deputy Director John E. Lanza announced at the October 19<sup>th</sup> Board meeting.

Three early voting locations have been established by the Board of Elections. The North Branch Library at 65 Halstead Street in Clinton, the Main Library at the Route 12 County Complex, 314 Rt. 12, in Raritan Township and at the 4-H Building on the South County Fairgrounds, 1207 NJ-179, in East Amwell.

Early voting, October 23 through the 31<sup>st</sup>, is available to voters Monday through Saturday, from 10 am until 8 pm and on Sundays, from 10 am to 6 pm.

Lanza, liaison to the County Clerk's Office and Board of Elections, said, "We are pleased that voters will have many opportunities to cast their ballots in 2021, including good old-fashioned voting in-person at your polling place on election day, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, something we missed in 2020," Lanza said.

Mary Melfi, Hunterdon County Clerk, added, "Voters may still choose the option to vote in- person at the County Clerk's office via a paper Vote By Mail ballot until Monday, November 1<sup>st</sup> at 3 pm. Hours are Monday – Friday, 8 am to 4 pm. Additional hours include Thursday, October 28<sup>th</sup> until 7 pm and Saturday, October 30<sup>th</sup> from 9 am to 1 pm. The County Clerk's office is located in the Hall of Records, 71 Main Street, Flemington."

Election Day, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, the polls are open 6 am to 8 pm.
