Hunterdon To Distribute At Home Covid-19 Test Kits After Testing Site Closes June 30th

**At Home Test Kits Available At Route 12 County Complex
July 13 and 20, 2 pm to 7 pm**

Hunterdon County residents will be able to pick up free at home Covid-19 test kits, from 2 to 7 pm on July 13 and July 20, at the County Complex on Route 12 in Raritan Township, as the County's test facility on Reaville Avenue, in Flemington ends operations at 4 pm on June 30th, County Commissioner Shaun C. Van Doren announced at the Commissioners' June 21st meeting.

Van Doren, the Board's Health Department liaison, reported, "While the successful testing site will close, the Department of Health will make free at home test kits available for residents to pick up at Building #1 at the County's Route 12 complex, on July 13 and 20, from 2 pm to 7 pm each day. No appointment is necessary.

The testing clinic has been seen as a great value by county residents and those who work here, as over 8000 tests have been administered since it opened on February 3rd."

Van Doren pointed out that area pharmacies are also supplying tests, reporting, "The Health Department advises that there are numerous other opportunities still available for testing, including all CVS, Rite Aid, and Walgreen pharmacies, as well as The Dr. Is In medical clinics in Flemington and Clinton, Bowkers Pharmacy in Milford, and the Holland Center Pharmacy.

The Commissioner added, "Our Health team will keep a close eye on covid-19 infections data and should there be a need to establish a clinic again, the Department will be prepared to do so."
