## **Hunterdon To Act On County Counsel And Deputy Administrator Positions Next Week**

Hunterdon County's Commissioners, at its July 5th meeting, will consider the promotion of the current County Counsel, Shana Taylor, of Kingwood, to the position of Deputy Administrator, and the appointment of Katrina Campbell, of Bethlehem, as the new County Counsel, Board Director John E. Lanza has announced.

Lanza stated, "The people of the County and the Board will benefit from having exceptional, experienced and knowledgeable talent in Ms. Taylor and Ms. Campbell, both of whom can move seamlessly into their respective new positions at the executive level should their appointments be approved."

The vacancy in the Deputy Administrator position resulted from the promotion of current Deputy Administrator Bradley Myhre to Administrator, following the retirement of County Administrator Kevin Davis.

Ms. Taylor's proposed promotion will create a vacancy in the post of County Counsel. Ms. Campbell will be considered for appointment to that position.

A member of the New Jersey Bar, Ms. Taylor has served as Hunterdon County Counsel for over ten years where she has provided legal guidance to all County Departments, Boards, Commissions, Constitutional Officers, and the Board of Commissioners. She previously was the County's Human Services and Mental Health Administrator.

Ms. Taylor holds her Juris Doctorate from the University of Dayton Law School and received a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Thomas Jefferson University.
